Executive Strategic Summary

This 5-year roadmap defines MAL’s strategic direction to scale high-impact grassroots interventions across Nakuru County, addressing climate vulnerability, economic barriers, and social exclusion.

Strategic Pillar 1: Climate-Smart Agriculture & Household Food Security

Expand tiered kitchen gardens, resilient seed sharing, and community tree nurseries to 5,000 households.

Strategic Pillar 2: Disability Mainstreaming & Adaptive Technology

Advance local accessibility adaptations, adaptive assistive devices, and economic opportunities.

Strategic Pillar 3: Women & Youth Technical Enterprise Incubation

Deliver vocational tailoring, digital skills, agro-processing, and micro-grant mentorship.

Strategic Pillar 4: Community Wellbeing, School Nutrition & Health Outreach

Partner with local public health units and primary schools on nutrition and mental health awareness.

Strategic Pillar 5: Organizational Excellence & Donor Transparency

Maintain real-time digital impact tracking, public financial reporting, and audited transparency.
